Chestnut Tree House Fundraising Success!

This year the Sixth Form Leadership set themselves the goal of raising enough money to pay for one day at Chestnut Tree House, a local children's hospice who cares for young people aged between 0-19 with progressive life-shortening conditions. This was a goal of £6,850.

Between a range of events and activities, the SPH community has smashed this goal – raising £10,445.76. This means since we have started supporting Chestnut Tree House as a school and sixth form, we have raised a total of £32,243.52 for the charity!

The most recent fundraising events included a Sixth Form Bingo game and a Reindeer Cash Dash where school staff dressed up in antlers and red noses to raise money! A special thank you to Miss Duckers who raised the most money, over £300.
